

## **Tec Requirements 2024**

for festivals and single shows

Karabooza independently splits all channels in an analog stage box located at the drummer's position. Split A automatically goes to X-Air 18 (in-ear monitor console). Split B is transferred to the front-of-house/engineer via a labeled and marked cable snake as follows:



Do not provide phantom power from the FOH console to the channels!

## T/ A D A D O O 7 A IN / A IU / A D O O L / A

The sound system must be appropriate for the venue.

There must be at least 1 sub-bass on each side. An FOH digital console with all the listed inserts and effects is an absolute prerequisite. Karabooza uses their own in-ear monitor setup with a custom in-ear mix from the drum rack. Stage power is provided by the organizer. We need stage power at all band positions as well as 2 outlets at the front of the stage.
